FINAL DECISION

Petitioner appeals from the Respondent Agency's termination of Emergency Assistance ("EA") benefits. The Agency terminated Petitioner's EA benefits because she failed to comply with her EA service plan ("SP"), without good cause. Because Petitioner appealed, the matter was transmitted to the Office of Administrative Law for a hearing. On June 9, 2015, the Honorable Joseph A. Ascione, Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ"), held a plenary hearing, took testimony and admitted documents.

On June 10, 2015, the ALJ issued his Initial Decision, affirming the Agency's determination. The ALJ found that Petitioner violated several SPs, without good cause. See Initial Decision at 4-5; see also Exhibits R-2, R-3, R-4, and R-5. Accordingly, the ALJ found that the Agency properly terminated Petitioner's EA benefits. Additionally, as a result of Petitioner's SP violation, she is ineligible for EA benefits for a period of six months, beginning May 31, 2015. See N.J.A.C. 10:90-6.6(a); see also Exhibit R-1 at 1.

No Exceptions to this Initial Decision were filed.

As the Director of the Division of Family Development, Department of Human Services, I have considered the ALJ's Initial Decision and following an independent review of the record, I concur with the ALJ's final conclusion in this matter and hereby ADOPT the Findings of Fact and Conclusion of Law in this matter.
