Notice of Administrative Change and

Announcement of Availability of a New General Permit (GP-009B) for Boiler(s) Each Greater than or Equal to 10 MMBTU/hr and Less than 50 MMBTU/hr

N.J.A.C. 7:27-8.8(c)

Take notice that the Department of Environmental Protection (Department) is announcing the availability of a new General Permit (GP) GP-009B for boiler(s) each greater than or equal to 10 million BTU per hour (MMBTU/hr) and less than 50 MMBTU/hr for minor facilities. This GP is replacing the current general permit GP-009A (Boiler(s) and Indirect Fired Process Heater(s) Each Greater Than or Equal to 10 MMBTU/hr and Less Than 50 MMBTU/hr Combusting Gaseous Fuel).

This general permit is available beginning on February 3, 2020, and is being included in the list of sources at N.J.A.C. 7:27-8.8(c) for which general permits are available.

GP-009B allows for the construction, installation, reconstruction, modification, and operation of a single or multiple boilers, each greater than or equal to 10 MMBTU/hr and less than 50 MMBTU/hr combusting natural gas (and no. 2 fuel oil during natural gas curtailment), where the total combined maximum natural gas limit for all boilers in this general permit shall not exceed 840 million standard cubic feet per year (MMSCF/yr).

A general permit is a pre-approved permit to construct, and certificate to operate, issued pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:27-8.8, for one or more types of similar sources at a minor facility. A minor facility operator with a qualifying source may register for, and operate under, the conditions of the general permit, rather than submit a case-by-case permit application.

The Department published notice of the proposed general permit in the August 19, 2019, New Jersey Register at 51 N.J.R. 1376(a) pursuant to the Air Pollution Control Act, N.J.S.A. 26:2C-9.2. No public comments were received during the 30-day comment period.

The general permit continues to provide for inspections and evaluations to ensure conformance with all provisions of N.J.A.C. 7:27. This general permit is issued under the authority of N.J.S.A. 26:2C-9.2 and N.J.A.C. 7:27-8.

Full text of the adoption follows:

SUBCHAPTER 2. NON-FINANCIAL ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

10:90-2.8 Individuals ineligible for WFNJ TANF/GA

(a) The following persons shall not be eligible for assistance and shall not be considered to be members of the WFNJ/TANF or WFNJ/GA assistance units:

1.-13. (No change.)

14. A person who is seeking legal guardianship of an unrelated child.

i. Although ineligible for TANF benefits, when needed, the WFNJ agency shall provide contact information to these cases for assistance in obtaining guardianship; and
