

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 15

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 14, declaring a State of Emergency across all 21 counties in New Jersey, was issued on Saturday, February 21, 2026, due to the anticipated statewide impact of a severe winter storm, including blizzard conditions, and heavy and widespread snow accumulations; and

WHEREAS, the severity of the conditions necessitating the State of Emergency declaration has eased;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MIKIE SHERRILL, Governor of the State of New Jersey, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the Statutes of this State, hereby ORDER and DIRECT:

1. The State of Emergency declared pursuant to Executive Order No. 14 (2026) is terminated effective 6:00 p.m., Eastern Standard Time, on Wednesday, February 25, 2026.
