

What is Data Dissemination?

- Process of communicating, distributing and/or transmitting statistical data to data users
- Dissemination method is a non-proprietary open system using the internet and media to reach target groups
- On May 9, 2013, open, machine-readable data became the new default for government information

What does the Census Bureau do?



The Census Bureau's mission is to serve as the leading source of quality data about the nation's people and economy.

Decennial Census

Every 10 years, counts people

American Community Survey (ACS)

Ongoing; data released annually; Social, Economic, Housing, and Demographic data

Other Surveys (over 130 annually)

Current Population Survey (CPS); National Crime and Victimization Survey (NCVS);
 Health Interview Survey (HIS); Consumer Expenditure Survey (CE); Population
 Estimates; Economic Census; Census of Governments; American Housing Survey

Why We Conduct a Census


Article I, Section 2 of the Constitution of the United States:

"Representation and direct Taxes shall be apportioned among the several States which may be included within this Union, according to their respective Numbers.

The actual Enumeration shall be made within three Years after the first Meeting of the Congress of the United States, and within every subsequent Term of ten Years, in such Manner as they shall by Law direct."

Census Methods: 1950 through 2000


- Short Form to 5 out of 6 households:
 - 6 demographic questions
 - 1 housing question
- Long Form to 1 out of 6 households:
 - Same as above plus
 - 26 population questions
 - 20 housing questions

Lingering Problem

Geography: by County

Because the census was only conducted once every 10 years, the data became unrepresentative in changing communities

Solution: American Community Survey

- Began in 2005 with a sample of households each month
- 3.54 Million housing units annually
- The only source of local statistics for 40 topics (education, employment, housing, disability, commuting, income, etc.)
- New Data Annually including small geographies






- Step two: Select your geography
 - County Subdivision = All Boroughs, Cities, Towns, Villages, and Townships in NJ




- Step three: After you select your geography, click "ADD TO YOUR SELECTIONS"
 - Tip click the "Map" tab to ensure you have the correct geography selected




 Step four: Click the "Topics" tab on the left side of the screen




- Step five: Select your Dataset (ACS 5-year or ACS 1-year)






