Purpose

To announce the issuance of Training and Employment Guidance Letter (TEGL) 41-14, Change 1, which provides guidance on training provider eligibility transition.

Background

Section 122(i) of the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) requires States, in partnership with local boards, to identify eligible training providers and programs that are qualified to receive WIOA title-B funds to train adults and dislocated workers, including those with disabilities. States were also required to establish transition procedures that allow training providers and programs that were eligible under WIA to continue to be eligible under WIOA until December 31, 2015 or until an earlier date established by the Governor. TEGL 4-14, Change 1, states that the Governor's transition procedure may allow *training providers and programs that were eligible under WIA to remain eligible under WIOA until June 30, 2016*. This will provide additional time for the transition, and reduce potential disruption to participants.

Required Action: This guidance should be shared with all relevant one-stop staff and partner agencies.
