<u>**DUTIES:**</u> Under the supervision of the Section Chief, and/or the Assistant Section Chief, Board of Public Utilities Section and the Assistant Attorneys General in the Administrative Practice Group, provides counsel and representation to the Board of Public Utilities including providing advice on clean energy initiatives, and advice and litigation services in matters involving ratepayers and third party vendors; performs other related duties as required.

## REQUIREMENTS

**EDUCATION:** Graduation from an accredited law school with a Juris Doctor. Admission to practice as an Attorney at Law in the State of New Jersey is required.

**EXPERIENCE:** Two years (2) years of experience as a practicing attorney.

**LICENSE:** Appointee will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.

**RESUME NOTE:** Eligibility determinations will be based upon information presented in resume only. Applicants who possess foreign degrees (degrees earned outside of the U.S.) are required to provide an evaluation indicating the U.S. equivalency prior to the closing date. Failure to do so will result in your ineligibility.
