<u>DUTIES:</u> Under the supervision of the Section Chief or Assistant Section Chief of the Education and Higher Education Section or the Assistant Attorneys General in charge of the Administrative Practice Group in Trenton will provide counsel and representation to the Department of Education; the legal work on behalf of the Department of Education includes administrative litigation and appeals regarding State funding of education, charter schools, and special education; does other related work as required.

REQUIREMENTS

EDUCATION: Graduation from an accredited law school with a Juris Doctor. Admission to practice as an Attorney at Law in the State of New Jersey is required.

EXPERIENCE: Two years (2) years of experience as a practicing attorney.

LICENSE: Appointee will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.

RESUME NOTE: Eligibility determinations will be based upon information presented in resume only. Applicants who possess foreign degrees (degrees earned outside of the U.S.) are required to provide an evaluation indicating the U.S. equivalency prior to the closing date. Failure to do so will result in your ineligibility.
