<u>DUTIES:</u> Under the supervision of Assistant Attorneys General in the Financial Affairs Practice Group, the Section Chief and/or the Assistant Section Chief of the Pensions and Financial Transactions Section, the Pensions deputies counsel the various Boards of Trustees of the State retirement systems during their open public meetings, on issues ranging from disability retirements to pension forfeitures to issues raised by members of the State retirement systems; does other related work as required.

REQUIREMENTS

EDUCATION: Graduation from an accredited law school with a Juris Doctor. Admission to practice as an Attorney at Law in the State of New Jersey is required.

EXPERIENCE: Two years (2) years of experience as a practicing attorney.

LICENSE: Appointee will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.

PREFERENCE: Preference will be given to applicants with excellent judgment and communication skills and experience in the areas of pensions and the Open Public Meetings Act.

RESUME NOTE: Eligibility determinations will be based upon information presented in resume only. Applicants who possess foreign degrees (degrees earned outside of the U.S.) are required to provide an evaluation indicating the U.S. equivalency prior to the closing date. Failure to do so will result in your ineligibility.

While completing the application you will be instructed to upload supporting documents including but not limited to: a resume, cover letter indicating vacancy #19-252, copy of a current Certificate of Good Standing with the Supreme Court of New Jersey, a legal writing sample with your name on it, a copy of your unofficial law school transcripts, and an Affirmative Action form.
