<u>DUTIES</u>: Under supervision of the Chief of Enforcement, or other supervisory official within the Department of Law and Public Safety, Office of Consumer Protection, plans, organizes, and supervises investigative teams or specialized investigators conducting in depth regulatory and administrative audits and inspections of licensed premises; reviews records, files, financial statements, and other transactions to determine compliance with rules or regulations governing consumer protection laws; performs other confidential and sensitive civil and regulatory investigative activities or specialized investigations to detect alleged noncompliance with or violations of New Jersey state statutes, administrative codes, or Professional Rules of Conduct, or consumer protection laws; supervises staff and work activities; prepares and signs official performance evaluations for subordinate staff; performs other related duties as required.

REQUIREMENTS

EDUCATION: Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Bachelor's degree.

EXPERIENCE: Five (5) years of experience in the conduct of civil or criminal investigations related to compliance, enforcement, detection, and surveillance activity, including the preparation of investigative reports; **OR** Five (5) years of experience in the conduct of investigative administrative audits and/or regulatory examinations of records maintained by businesses and organizations; **OR** Five (5) years of experience in the conduct of investigations for the government, the military, consumer protection programs, public advocacy organizations, or the public interest; **AND** One (1) year of the five (5) years of experience shall have been in a team leader or lead investigator capacity.

Applicants who do not possess the required education may substitute experience as indicated on a year-for-year basis.

Completion of a supervised internship field placement of 300 hours in an undergraduate curriculum in Criminal Justice or a related degree program may be substituted for one (1) year of the non-supervisory experience. A copy of your transcript indicating completion of the internship as part of your undergraduate degree program must be provided in order to meet this substitution requirement. Failure to do so may result in disqualification.

A Juris Doctorate degree or a Master's Degree in Criminal Justice, Public Administration, Business Administration, Law, or a related field may be substituted for one (1) year of the non-supervisory experience.

LICENSE: Appointee will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is required to perform the essential duties of the position.

PREFERENCE: Preference will be given to candidates with an accounting background and/or significant experience in conducting large, complex civil investigations involving charitable organizations, financial fraud, and/or complex financial wrongdoing.

RESUME NOTE: Eligibility determinations will be based upon information presented in resume only. Applicants who possess foreign degrees (degrees earned outside of the U.S.) are required to provide an evaluation indicating its U.S. equivalency prior to the closing date. Failure to do so may result in disqualification.
