OPERATION HIRE A JERSEY HERO

Photo left: Building on the Christie Administration's commitment to support New Jersey's veterans, Acting Gov. Kim Guadagno, left, joined Administration officials and business leaders to launch the Operation Hire a Jersey Hero Symposium at Prudential's headquarters in Newark April 3. The event focused on promoting job opportunities for veterans by connecting employers with state resources available to support the hiring of veterans. The Christie Administration created the symposium series after hearing from Garden State employers who sought information on how to recruit veterans and how military skills can be translated into civilian employment. Gov. Christie has also signed various pieces of legislation to assist veterans, including bills to strengthen the support network for military families after the death of a service member; establish a program that awards high school diplomas to veterans who dropped out to serve in World War II, Korea and Vietnam; honor Gold Star Families with a special license plate for families of members of the military killed in action for their sacrifice; establish the New Jersey National Guard State Family Readiness Council Fund; ensure funding for the Veteran to Veteran Peer Support Program telephone helpline; and reinvigorate programs like Helmets2Hardhats to put veterans back to work.
