Full Time Support services include:

- ❖ Legal consultation for adverse administrative actions
- ❖ Subject rights consultation (OCI or 15-6 investigations, commanders inquiries, and more)
- ❖ Consultation on possible ramifications of civilian criminal matters

We will put you in contact with your state Defense Counsel for the following:

- ❖ Representation at administrative boards
- ❖ NJP (Article 15) consultations
- ❖ Appeals of adverse actions to state separation authority
