SUBJECT: **Veteran's Designation**

Effective July 1, 2016, the New Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission (MVC) will be unveiling a new, permanently-imprinted veteran's designation for driver's licenses and non-driver IDs.

The current practice allows a customer to receive a veteran's designation **sticker** to affix to the top right hand corner of their driver's license or non-driver ID by mail or in person at an MVC agency after showing certain documents to prove veteran's status.

The new process will remain the same with the exception that the stickers will no longer be provided. Instead, the MVC will issue a new driver's license or non-driver ID with a **permanently imprinted** veteran's designation in the endorsements section. See the attached image for reference:
