Proposed Amendment to Rules — Motorized Bicycle Regulations (Amended)

TRENTON — The New Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission has proposed an amended rule pertaining to Motorized Bicycles.

The proposed amendment revises the rules to implement specific conditions of compliance necessary to align with the relevant statutes as currently enacted with respect to the definition of motorized bicycle, a motorized bicycle license expiring on an individual's birthdate, and the elimination of the requirement for lawful presence in the United States to obtain a standard motorized bicycle license or learner's permit, as well as bringing consistency to the visual acuity testing standards. The Commission's proposal was published in the December 16, 2024, issue of the New Jersey Register.
