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NJMVC Facilities to Close for the State Holiday on Monday, September 7

TRENTON — All New Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission (NJMVC) facilities, including agencies, road test sites, and inspection stations, will be closed Monday, September 7, 2026, in observance of the state holiday.

The facilities will remain open for normal business hours the rest of this week, including Saturday, September 5.

The Commission's website, NJMVC.gov, is open and accessible 24/7, providing a convenient way for customers to complete their motor vehicle business. Over 25 online services are available, including driver license renewals and replacements, vehicle registration renewals and replacements, address changes, driver record requests, personalized and specialty plate requests, and more.

New Jerseyans seeking motor vehicle services should always visit the website first to use online services, schedule appointments for in-person services, verify what to bring for their NJMVC visit, and find answers to common customer questions.

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
