LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS — WAIVER FORM

N.J.S.A. 43:15A-98 provides that any person who becomes eligible for enrollment as a Law Enforcement Officer (LEO) in the Public Employees' Retirement System (PERS) will be enrolled within 90 days unless he or she waives the privilege of enrolling as a LEO.

I understand that the PERS statute provides, whether I waive my right to participate as a LEO or not, that:

- Non-veteran employees holding a LEO position must be retired on a Service Retirement upon the attainment of age 65.
- Veteran employees holding a LEO position and lacking 20 years of service upon the attainment of age 65 must retire as soon as they have 20 years of service or on attainment of age 70, whichever is earlier.

In accordance with N.J.S.A. 43:15A-98, I hereby waive my privilege of enrolling as a LEO and shall hereafter be treated in all respects as a non-LEO of the PERS system, except with regard to the compulsory retirement provisions indicated above.
