**Re: OPRA request received June 28, 2024**

Dear Mr. Warren:

The New Jersey Educational Facilities Authority (“NJEFA” or the “Authority”) received your Open Public Records Act (“OPRA”) request On June 28, 2024. The official Records Custodian, Jamie O’Donnell, also received your OPRA request on June 28, 2024. As such, the seven (7) business day deadline to respond to your request is July 10, 2024. This response to your request is being provided to you on the 1<sup>st</sup> business day after the custodian’s receipt of said request.

Your OPRA request sought access to the following:

*The current inventory of the New Jersey Educational Facilities Authority’s vehicle fleet.*

Please be advised that the Authority does not have a vehicle fleet.

This response does not waive or limit any other rights afforded this Authority under OPRA, which are all expressly reserved. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 47:1A-5(b), the cost associated with this request is \$0.00. If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the NJEFA to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625, by e-mail at [grc@dca.state.nj.us](mailto:grc@dca.state.nj.us), or at their web site at [www.state.nj.us/grc](http://www.state.nj.us/grc). The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
