## INTRODUCTION

A grand total of 946 projects were filmed in New Jersey during 2015. These include 67 features, a mini-series, 191 television series and specials, 37 music videos, 237 industrial, educational, documentary and short films, 362 commercials and 51 webcasts.

This production generated \$62.5 million for the New Jersey economy.

Since 1978, the Commission's first year of operation, 21,505 projects have been shot in the Garden State, enhancing the local economy by over \$2 billion.




