## INTRODUCTION

During the 2017 production year, 884 projects were filmed throughout New Jersey, This includes 53 feature films, 3 telefilms and mini-series, 152 television series and specials, 33 music videos, 170 industrial, documentary, educational and short films, 440 commercials and stills and 33 web programs and series.

This production work generated \$67,065,062 for the New Jersey economy.

Since 1978, the New Jersey Motion Picture and Television Commission's inaugural year, the Commission has attracted a grand total of 23,308 projects to the Garden State, enhancing the local economy by over \$2.2 billion.

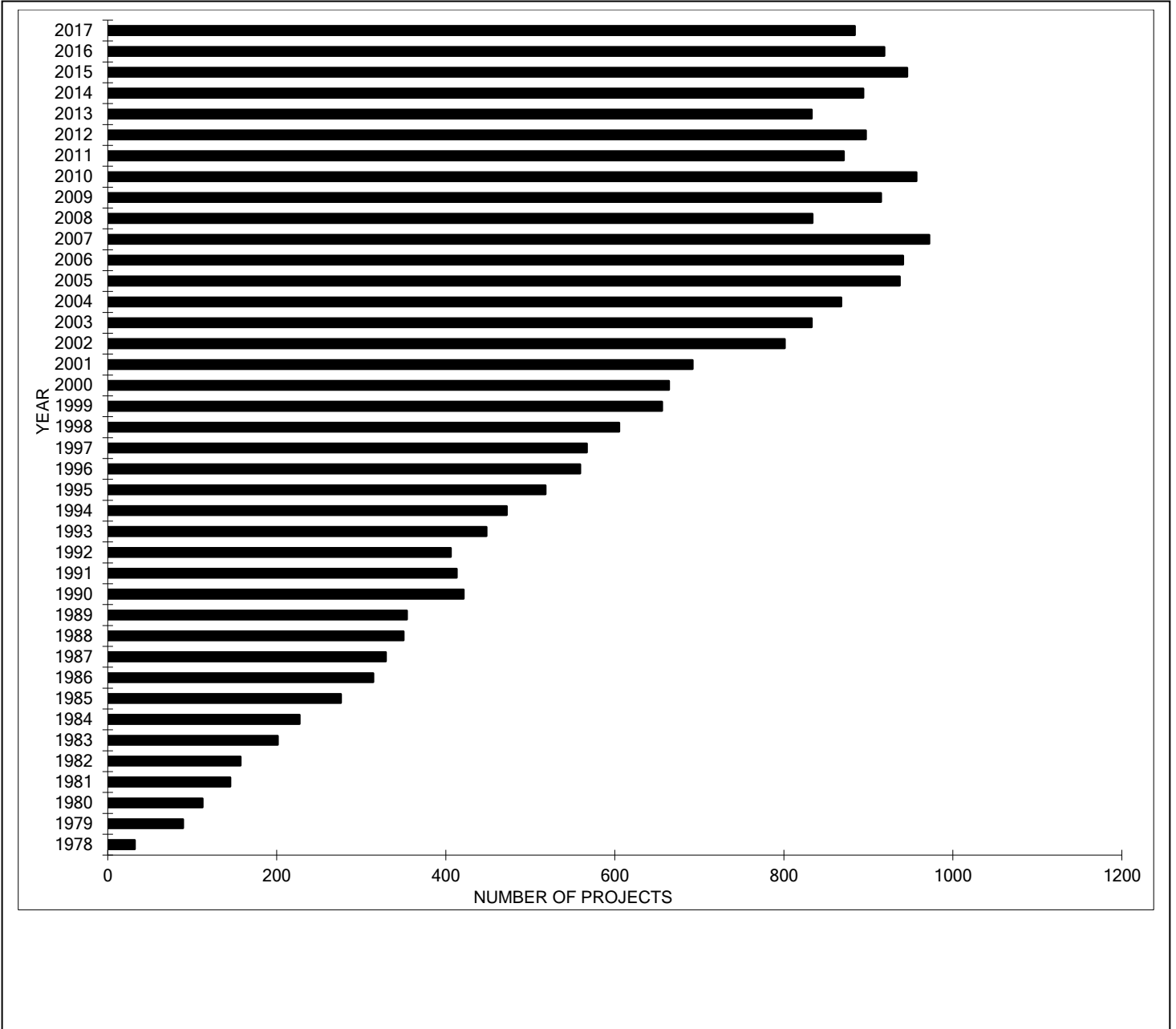

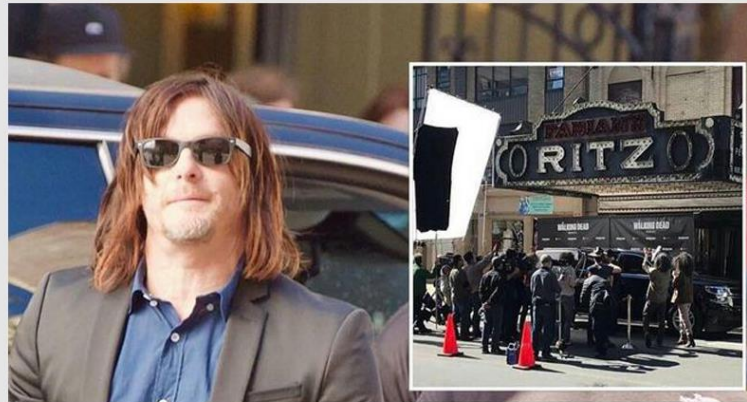

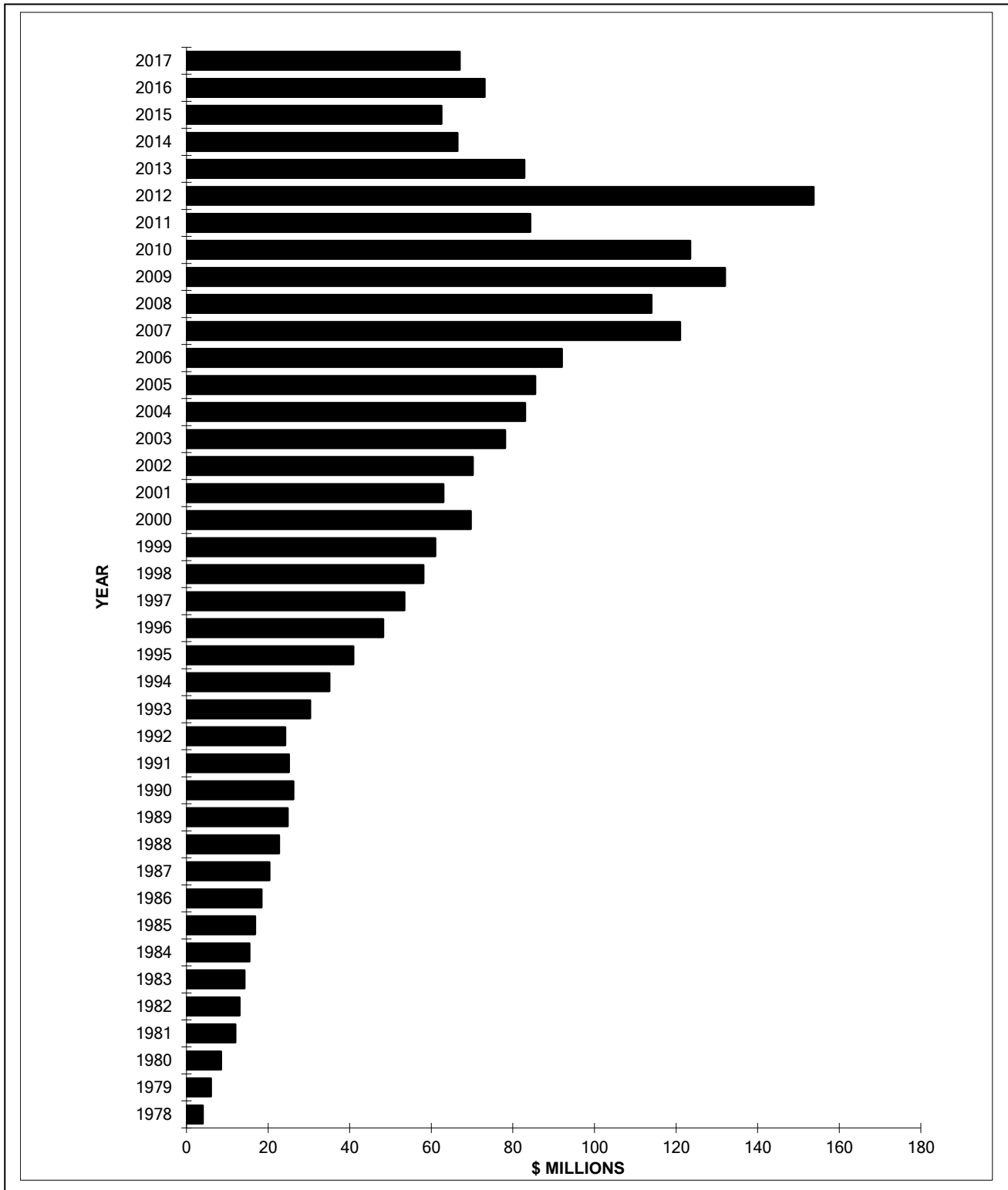
