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| <p>THEATRICAL– (Professional employment in a theatrical production, including stage, motion picture, commercial, web-series and television performances, and rehearsals therefore.)</p> | <p style="text-align: center;">NONE</p> <p>Minors under 16 must be accompanied at all times by an adult who is a parent, guardian, or an adult who, in writing, is granted temporary guardianship.</p> <p>Minors under 8 years old are required to have a medical note signed by the doctor, stating that the child is in good health.</p> | <p>Under 16 – Not more than 2 shows or productions daily or 8 weekly. 5 Hours daily, 24 hours weekly, 6 days a week. (includes rehearsal time. Combined hours of school and work not to exceed 8 hours daily.)</p> <p>16-18 – 8 hours daily 40 hours weekly 6 days a week</p> | <p>Under 16 Before 7 A.M. After 11:30 P.M.</p> <p>16-18 Before 6 A.M. After 11:30 P.M.</p> | <p>Emergent Permit required for a given minor working no more than 2 days on a given production.</p> <p>Formal Permit required for a given minor working from three days up to three months on a given production.</p> |
