

2011 Halloween Weekend Nor'Easter' New Jersey Office of Emergency Management Response/Recovery Situation Report November 3, 2011 - 9:00 a.m.

The NJROIC and NJOEM continue to monitor a winter storm event in coordination with the NWS. At 4:00PM, Saturday, October 29, 2011 and State Emergency Operations Center was activated and will remain staffed 24/7, as long as conditions dictate.

Governor Christie has signed an order due to the current emergency that lifts restrictions placed on commercial carrier hours of service relative to work associated with utility restoration. <u>This is limited to operators of vehicles involved in the restoration</u> of utility service within the State of New Jersey. **Expires on Nov 7, 2011.** 

# NJ Transit

Morristown Line Service has been restored between Lake Hopatcong and Mt Olive. Service between Hackettstown and Mt Olive will remain suspended until further notice. Bus bridge provided between Lake Hopatcong and Mt Olive. Until further notice, Morris and Essex Line trains may experience 10 to 20 minute delays due to speed restrictions caused by ongoing storm related repairs.
