ICS 200.C Course Overview:

This 2-day course is designed to enable personnel to operate efficiently during an incident or event within the Incident Command System (ICS). ICS-200 provides training on and resources for personnel who are likely to assume a supervisory position within the ICS.

Prerequisites:

The following courses are mandatory prerequisites to this course and must be included with your application. You will NOT be registered without proper required documents. Please provide all prerequisite documents as one file upon registration.

- IS-100.C (Introduction to ICS)- available on FEMA as Independent Study
- IS-700.B (Intro to NIMS)- available on FEMA as Independent Study
- IS-800.D (National Response Framework, An Intro)- available on FEMA as Independent Study

Selection Criteria:

Applicants will be selected based on properly completed applications, completed prerequisites, and whole community representation. **Class size is limited to 30 students.**
