

New Jersey Silver Alert Criteria

- A. The missing person who is believed to be suffering from Alzheimer's, dementia, or other cognitive impairment, regardless of age and:
 - 1. Is operating a known motor vehicle.
 - 2. Is entered into NCIC as a missing person.
 - 3. Is believed to be in danger of death or serious bodily injury. The law enforcement agency must be able to substantiate or specify what causes this belief.
- B. Operating a motor vehicle with any form of dementia, Alzheimer's, and other cognitive impairment is not automatically a Silver Alert.
- C. The lead law enforcement agency requesting a Silver Alert activation shall contact the NJSP ROIC, (609) 963-6900 for authentication and broadcast.
