

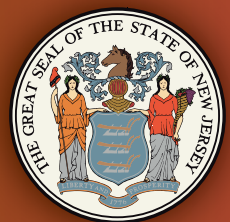

INTRODUCTION

The violence within the American domicile has been recognized for decades by elements of government and society with little done to correct the problem. Only recently has this phenomenon begun to receive the attention it deserves. In an effort to understand, identify and treat the incidents of abuse occurring in the home, the State of New Jersey, through its legislature, has provided the means to gain a meaningful insight into this issue.

In 1982, the Domestic Violence Act was instituted to protect battered victims and study the complex problems that spark such aggressive behavior. This legislation also provided the opportunity to identify the causes of violence in the home and put forth a more comprehensive effort to combat the crime of Domestic Violence.

Improvements since the implementation of the Domestic Violence Act are continuing. Pursuant to a change in N.J.S.A. 2C:25-24 enacted June 9, 1999, arrest data is presented by county. Domestic Violence restraining order violations are now captured and reported. Revised investigation and reporting procedures by the police; improved processing of domestic complaints by the courts; mandatory in-service training for police and court personnel have all enabled the victim to come forward and implement the constitutional rights granted to all Americans.

The following pages of narrative and graphics in this chapter are the result of gathered data displaying the complexities of domestic violence found within the State of New Jersey. It is through analysis of this data that, hopefully, the keys to preventing future violence can be found.

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DOMESTIC VIOLENCE STATISTICAL SUMMARY

Highlights of the 2014 domestic violence statistics are listed below:

- There were 62,055 domestic violence offenses reported by the police in 2014, a 4 percent decrease compared to the 64,556 reported in 2013.
- Murders decreased 5 percent in 2014 (42) when compared to 2013 (44).
- Assaults accounted for 43 percent (26,780) and harassment accounted for 43 percent (26,463) of the reported offenses in 2014.
- Arrests were made in 31 percent (19,323) of the offenses reported for 2014, a decrease of 4 percent when compared to arrests made in 2013.
- The most frequent day of domestic violence occurrences was Sunday (10,859).
- For the thirty-second consecutive year, the most frequent hours of domestic violence incidents were between 8:00 p.m. and midnight, when 25 percent (15,625) of the offenses were reported.
- Children were involved or present during 29 percent of all domestic violence offenses occurring in 2014. Specifically, 4 percent (2,681) were involved and 25 percent (15,216) were present.
- Females were victims in 75 percent (46,399) of all domestic violence offenses.
- The number of domestic violence complaints that had prior court orders issued against the offender decreased from 10,929 in 2013 to 10,840 in 2014. This is a decrease of 1 percent.
- Alcohol and/or drugs were involved in 26 percent (16,065) of the reported offenses occurring in 2014. Alcohol involvement alone accounted for 23 percent (14,419) of the total domestic violence offenses reported.
- Persons age 60 or over (elderly) were victims in 5 percent (3,301) of all reported domestic violence offenses that occurred in 2014 and were the victims in 26 percent (11) of the domestic violence murders (42).
- Domestic violence does not occur at a regular frequency, but when viewed as a ratio of its occurrence to a fixed time interval, one act of domestic violence would occur every 8 minutes and 47 seconds.
- Domestic violence offenses arising from a dating relationship accounted for 15 percent (9,092) of the state total.
- There were 2,667 total arrests involving domestic violence restraining orders reported by police in 2014. Of these, 1,391 were arrests for violations of a restraining order **only**, while 1,276 were arrests for violations of a restraining order **with** an offense arrest.

- Twenty-seven percent (17,002) of all domestic violence complaints resulted in injury. This is a decrease of 2 percent when compared to the 17,346 that occurred in 2013.
- Of all the domestic violence offenses involving weapons (28,936) - hands, fists, feet, etc., were used in 92 percent (26,599) of these offenses.
- Domestic violence offenses involving a firearm decreased 1 percent when compared to 2013.
- Serious injuries were reported in 1,352 offenses, an increase of 2 percent when compared to the 1,323 reported in 2013.

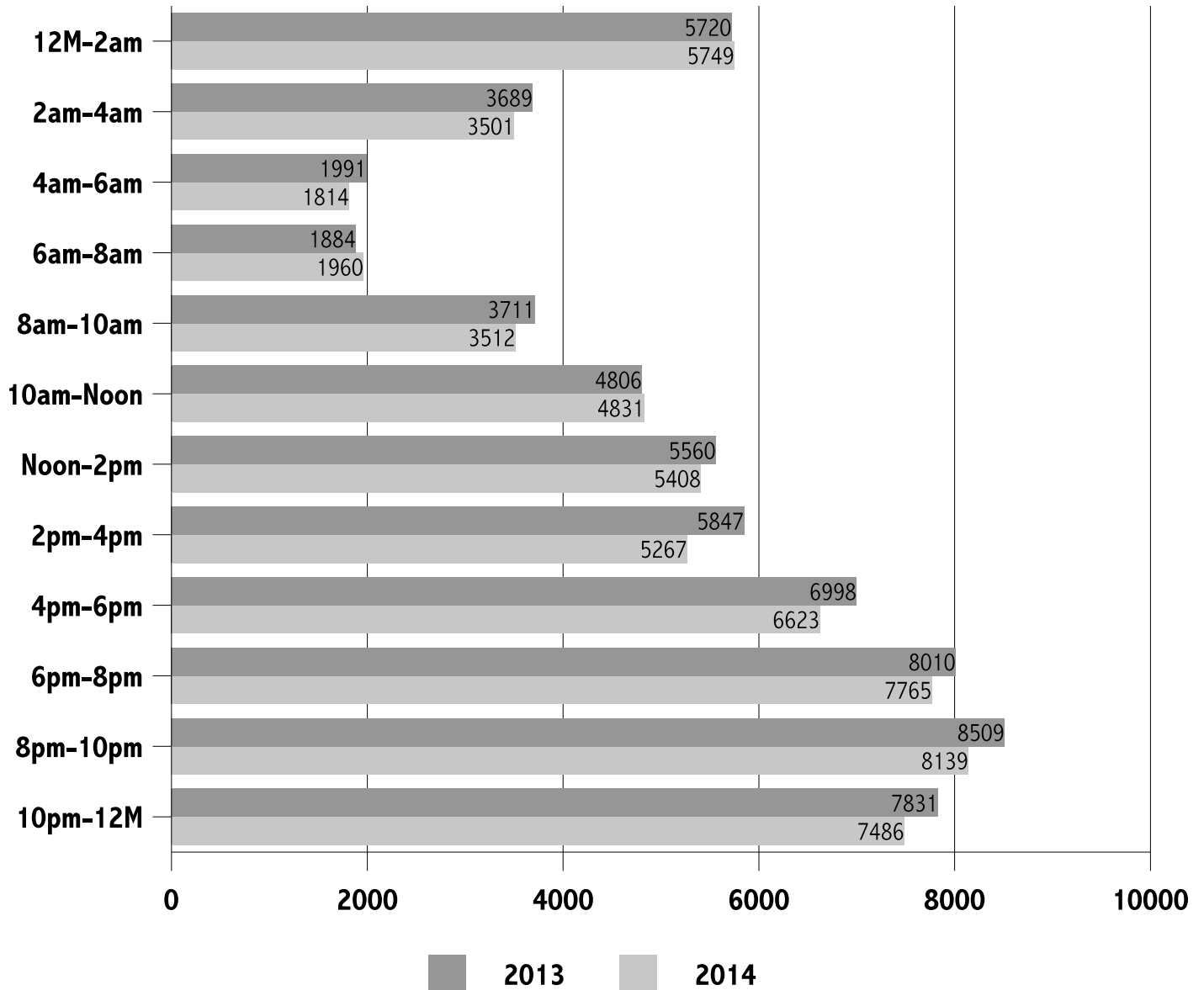

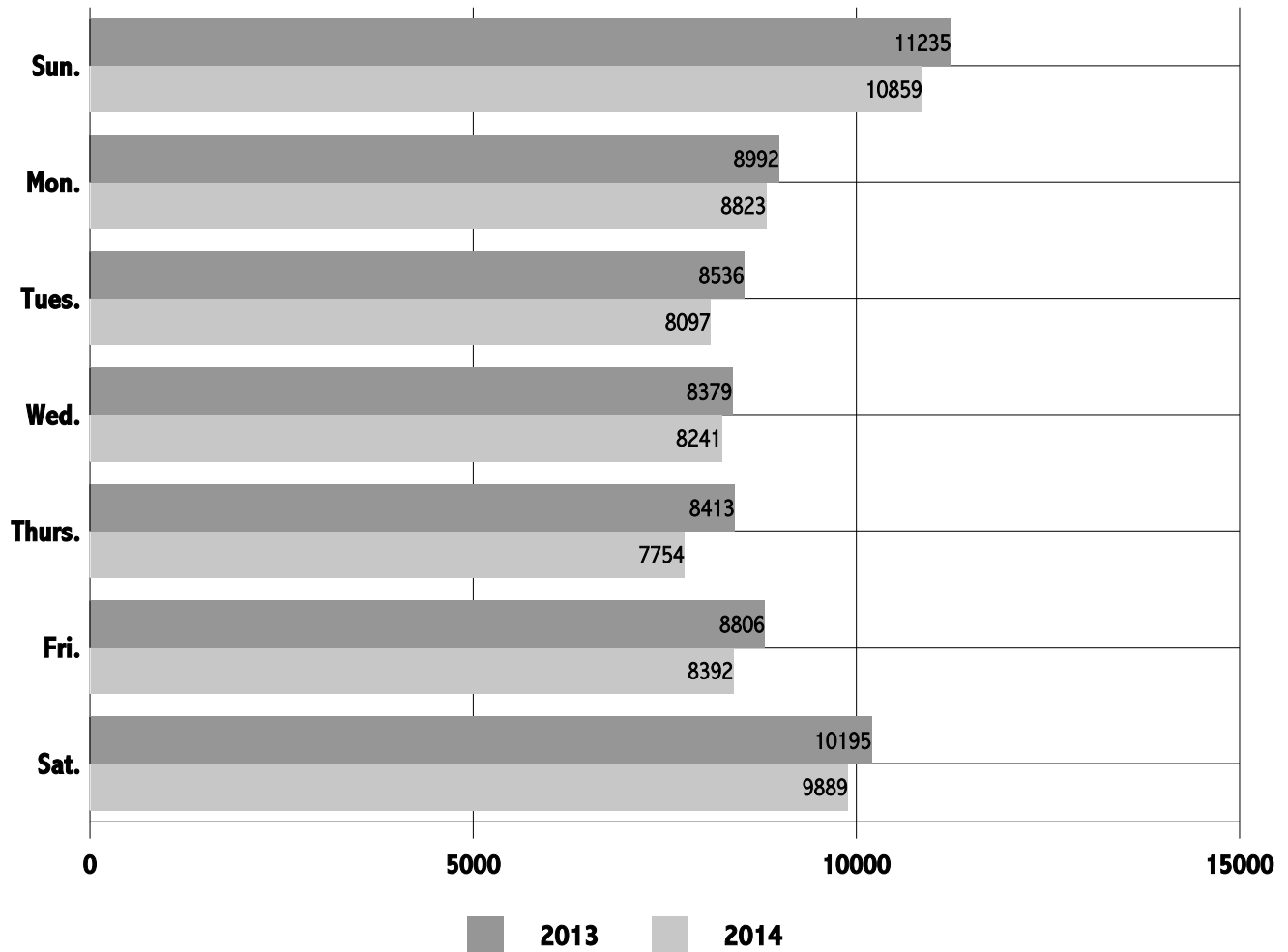
- Assaults accounted for 37 percent (1,234) of all domestic violence offenses for victims 60 years old or over.
- Females age 60 or over were the victims in 61 percent (2,014) of the 3,301 elderly abuse offenses.
- Persons age 60 or over were the victims in 5 percent (3,301) of all the reported domestic violence offenses during this period.

DOMESTIC VIOLENCE OFFENSES BY TIME OF DAY 2013/2014



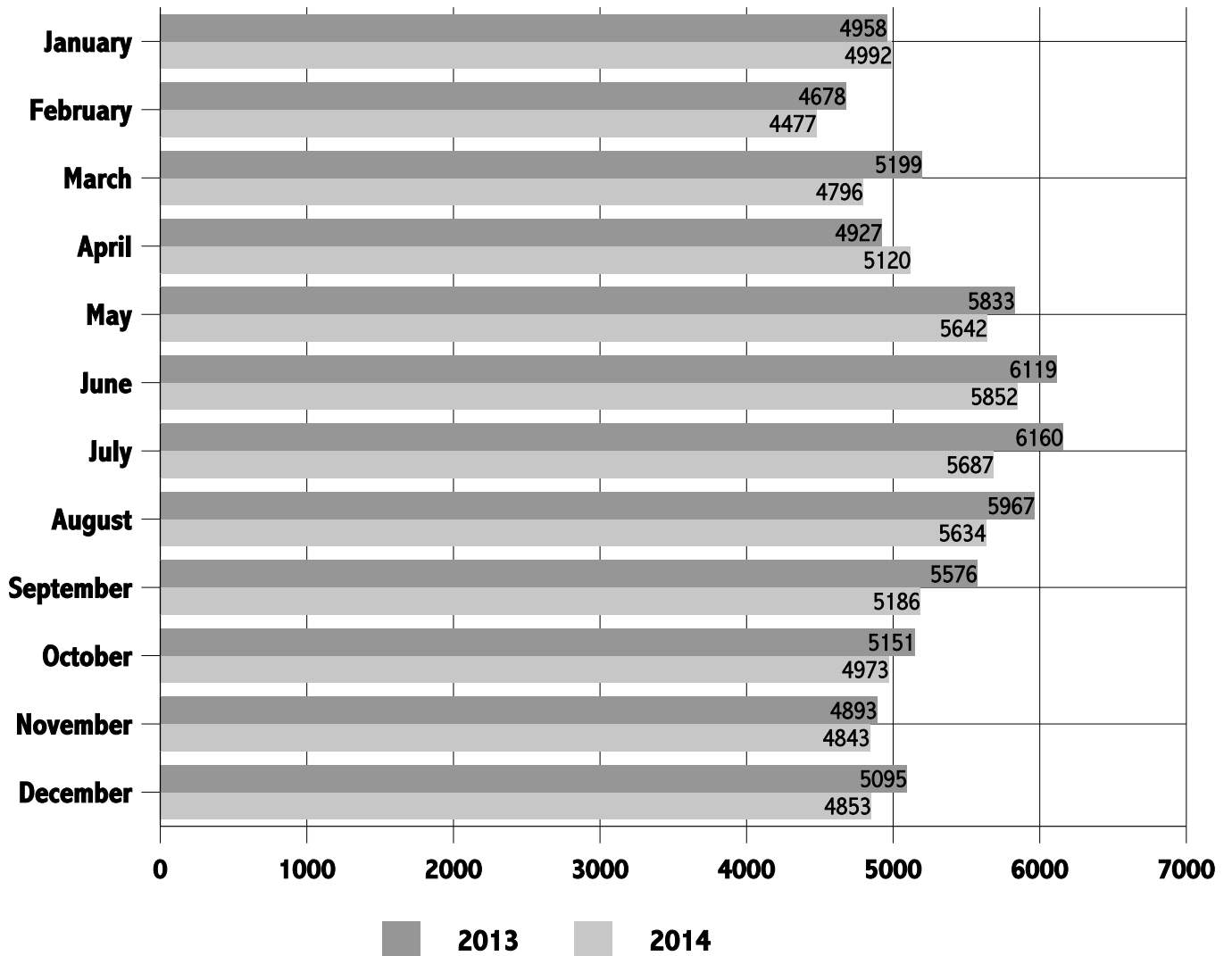
- During 2014, 25 percent (15,625) of the reported domestic violence offenses occurred between 8:00 p.m. and 12 midnight.

- Sunday recorded the highest number of occurrences in 2014 with 10859 offenses.
- During 2014, 33 percent (20,748) of the reported domestic violence offenses occurred during the weekend (Saturday and Sunday).

- In 2014, the highest number of domestic violence offenses occurred during the month of June.
