


REMINDER FOR FAITH COMMUNITIES

- 3. Stay Connected:** Join or host observances via phone, video conferencing or via live streaming on social media.




FOLLOW COVID-19 GUIDANCE WHEN OBSERVING RELIGIOUS HOLIDAYS & FESTIVALS:
