# SFY21 Body-Worn Camera Grant Program (BWC Grant Program).

### b. Purpose:

The Body-Worn Camera Grant Program is designed to provide eligible law enforcement agencies with state funding to aid in purchase of body-worn cameras, ancillary equipment and storage.

### c. Amount of money in the fund:

\$57,500,000 is available for distribution in the SFY 2021 funding cycle.

### d. Organizations which may apply for funding under this program:

Any State, county or municipal law enforcement agency in New Jersey may apply for funding. For purposes of eligibility for funding under this program, organizations that may apply include public college and university police departments but does not include correctional law enforcement agencies..
