DUTIES: Under immediate supervision of an Administrator of Investigations or other supervising investigator in the Division of Gaming Enforcement, Department of Law and Public Safety, assists in performing gross revenue audits in accordance with an established Master Audit Program to certify the accuracy of the reported casino gross revenue as filed on monthly tax reports required pursuant to N.J.A.C. 13:69L for the Atlantic City casinos and Internet Gaming Companies; participates in extensive field and office training on the operations, procedures, and policies of the Division of Gaming Enforcement; performs other related duties as required.

REQUIREMENTS

EDUCATION: Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Bachelor's degree.
