DUTIES: Under supervision of the Director and Deputy Director, Budget and Grants Operations Section in the Department of Law and Public Safety, manages the fiscal component of grants for the Department; monitors and reconciles grant expenditures and payments, maintains records of payments, coordinate with Grant Program Managers to ensure compliance with State and Federal guidelines, supervises fiscal grant related staff; performs other related duties as assigned.

REQUIREMENTS

EDUCATION: Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Bachelor's degree in Economics, Finance, Business Administration, Accounting, or Public Administration, with a minimum of twenty-one (21) semester hour credits in finance, economics, and/or accounting courses.

EXPERIENCE: Five (5) years of experience in work involving fiscal management. The experience should include work in public finance, auditing, budgeting, or accounting. One (1) year of the required experience shall have been in a supervisory capacity.

NOTE: A valid New Jersey certificate as a Certified Public Accountant or a registration as a Public Accountant issued by the New Jersey State Board of Public Accounts may be substituted for the Bachelor's degree.

A general Bachelor's degree supplemented by a minimum of twenty-one (21) semester hour credits in finance, economics, and/or accounting courses and two (2) years of work in public finance, auditing, budgeting, or accounting may be substituted for the specific degree requirements for all levels.

LICENSE: Appointees will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.

RESUME NOTE: Eligibility determinations will be based upon information presented in resume only. Applicants who possess foreign degrees (degrees earned outside of the U.S.) are required to provide an evaluation indicating the U.S. equivalency prior to the closing date. Failure to do so will result in your ineligibility.
