<u>DUTIES</u>: Under the direction of the Counsel to the Director or other supervisory official, represents the Division of Alcoholic Beverage Control as prescribed by applicable statutes; provides counsel to the Director and Division regarding interpretation of Title 33, The Alcoholic Beverage Control Act, and implementing regulations; as the Attorney General's representative, participates in legal and related activities involving cases in federal, State and local jurisdictions and before other State agencies; drafts petition responses, special rulings, Division orders on agency final decisions, and on a variety of matters involving alcoholic beverage licensing, permitting and other related topics; conducts legal research and related work of a complex nature; drafts regulations; responds to inquiries from the public, licensees and attorneys; does other related work as required.

REQUIREMENTS

EDUCATION: Graduation from an accredited law school with a Juris Doctor. Admission to practice law in the State of New Jersey is required.

EXPERIENCE:

DEPUTY ATTORNEY GENERAL 4: Two (2) years of experience as a practicing attorney. DEPUTY ATTORNEY GENERAL 3: Three (3) years of experience as a practicing attorney.

LICENSE: Appointee will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.

SPECIAL NOTE: Current Department employees appointed to a Deputy Attorney General 4 or 3 title must be willing to accept a lateral transfer, if selected.

PREFERENCE: Preference will be given to applicants with a background in administrative law, especially in researching, drafting and defending regulations in appropriate forums.

RESUME NOTE: Eligibility determinations will be based upon information presented in resume only. Applicants who possess foreign degrees (degrees earned outside of the U.S.) are required to provide an evaluation indicating the U.S. equivalency prior to the closing date. Failure to do so will result in your ineligibility.
