NUMBER OF POSITIONS AVAILABLE: Two (2)

<u>DUTIES</u>: Under the general supervision of a supervisory official in the Budget and Grant Operations Section, Office of the Attorney General, Department of Law and Public Safety will conduct site visits to audit for grant compliance; perform complex audits to determine compliance with grant specifications; determine fiscal impact of grant activities, prepare complex reports and evaluations; make recommendations for grant documents, proposals, and grant applications; assist in the implementation of the electronic grants system as needed; does other related duties as required.

REQUIREMENTS

EDUCATION: Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Bachelor's degree including or supplemented by twenty-one (21) semester hour credits in any combination of Accounting, Business Administration, Economics, or Finance courses.

EXPERIENCE: Four (4) years of experience in work involving fiscal analysis and evaluation, budgeting, and management operations in government, business, and/or a management consulting firm.

NOTE: Applicants who do not possess the Bachelor's degree, but who do possess the twenty-one (21) semester hour credits as listed above, may substitute the remaining education with experience as indicated above on a year-for-year basis with thirty (30) semester hour credits being equal to one (1) year of experience.

<u>NOTE:</u> A Master's degree in one of the areas listed above may be substituted for one (1) year of experience; a Doctorate in one of the areas listed above may be substituted for two (2) years of experience.

LICENSE: Appointees will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.

SPECIAL NOTE: Positions will be filled on a part-time, temporary basis. Candidates selected to fill vacancies will be limited to 944 work hours in a fiscal year.

RESUME NOTE: Eligibility determinations will be based upon information presented in resume only. Applicants who possess foreign degrees (degrees earned outside of the U.S.) are required to provide an evaluation indicating the U.S. equivalency prior to the closing date. Failure to do so may result in your ineligibility.
