DUTIES: Under the direction of a Youth Work Supervisor, or other supervisory official at the Juvenile Medium Security Facility assists in therapeutic programs pertaining to the implementation of Victim Impact Training and Speakers Bureau Forums at JJC sites and other public settings; participates in community service projects; assists JJC residents with completion of Victim Impact Training and Speakers Bureau Training; completes training reports, vehicle reports, and site visit reports; does other related duties as required.

REQUIREMENTS

EXPERIENCE: One (1) year of experience in the direct care and/or training of children with social, emotional, psychological and/or behavioral problems in a residential or community centered program.

NOTE: Thirty (30) semester credit hours from an accredited college, which shall have included at least twelve (12) semester credit hours in the behavioral sciences may be substituted for one (1) year of experience.
