**DUTIES:** Under direction of the director of the Administrator, Police Training Commission, Division of Criminal Justice or other supervisory official in the Department of Law and Public Safety, is responsible for the confidential and sensitive administrative and regulatory audits, coordination of civil and licensing investigations for the detection of alleged noncompliance with or violations of New Jersey state statutes, or administrative codes, or Professional Rules of Conduct for the purpose of consumer protection; performs other related duties as required.

### **REQUIREMENTS**

**EDUCATION:** Graduation from an accredited college with a Bachelor's Degree.

**EXPERIENCE:** Six (6) years of experience in the conduct of civil or criminal investigations related to compliance, enforcement, detection, or surveillance activity, including the preparation of investigative reports; **OR** Six (6) years of experience in the conduct of investigative administrative audits and/or regulatory examinations of records maintained by businesses and organizations; **OR** Six (6) years of experience in the conduct of investigations for the government, the military, consumer protection programs, public advocacy organizations, or the public interest; **AND** Three (3) years of the six (6) years of experience shall have been in the administration of investigative programs, initiatives, and regulatory and administrative audits.

Applicants who do not possess the required education may substitute experience as indicated on a year-for-year basis.

Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Master's Degree in Criminal Justice, Public Administration, Business Administration, or a related field may be substituted for one (1) year of the indicated nonsupervisory experience.

**LICENSE:** Appointee will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey.

**RESUME NOTE:** Eligibility determinations are based upon information presented in resume only.
