DUTIES: Under direction of the Finance and Operation Unit Manager and/or Director's designee, assists with the review, recording and processing of financial transactions and management of finance matters for the Division; managing and processing of the financial transactions via multiple various databases and applications; receives downloaded electronic payment data, approves traditional deposits and assists with financial requests; troubleshoots and offers solutions regarding financial management and assists with budget inquiries and planning; addresses and resolves accounting inquiries with consumers; assists with the oversight of the procurement process, conducts inventory reviews and orders supplies; participates in the review process of the ABC online licensing web portal related projects; may be assigned additional special projects and tasks; performs other related duties as required.

REQUIREMENTS

EDUCATION: Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Bachelor's degree.

EXPERIENCE: Three (3) years of experience in program management with responsibility for planning, organizing, coordinating, staffing, reporting, and budgeting, or in assisting an executive with program development and implementation.

<u>NOTE</u>: Applicants who do not possess the required education may substitute additional experience as indicated on a year-for-year basis.

<u>NOTE</u>: A Master's degree in Public Administration, Business Administration, Management, or other closely related field may be substituted for one (1) year of experience.

LICENSE: Appointee will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is required to perform the essential duties of the position.

<u>PREFERENCE</u>: Preference will be given to applicants who possess a working knowledge of financial concepts and/or computer technology acumen.

<u>RESUME NOTE</u>: Eligibility determinations will only be based upon information presented in resume. Applicants who possess foreign degrees (degrees earned outside of the U.S.) are required to provide an evaluation indicating its U.S. equivalency prior to the closing date.
