<u>DUTIES</u>: Under general supervision in the Department of Law and Public Safety, Division of Highway Traffic Safety, independently audits federal and state grant agreements and financial reports for the Office of Highway Traffic Safety; performs other related duties.

REQUIREMENTS

EDUCATION: Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Bachelor's degree, including or supplemented by twenty-one (21) semester hour credits hours in accounting.

NOTE: Possession of a valid Certificate as a Certified Public Accountant issued by the New Jersey Board of Accountancy may be substituted for the Bachelor's degree.

<u>NOTE</u>: Applicants who have successfully completed the required twenty-one (21) semester hour credits in accounting, but who do not possess a Bachelor's degree, may substitute additional experience as indicated on a year-for-year basis (30 credit hours is considered equal to one (1) year of college).

EXPERIENCE: Two (2) years of accounting or auditing experience.

LICENSE: Appointee will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.

Appointees will be required to be compliant with all Executive Orders (EO), mandates, policies, and directives related to Covid-19, including testing and vaccinations, and including but not limited to EO 252 (Murphy), EO 283 (Murphy) and/or EO 290 (Murphy).
