<u>DUTIES</u>: Under direction of a Crew Supervisor or other supervisor in the Department of Law and Public Safety, inspects, maintains and repairs marine vessels, engines and other equipment used on state patrol vessels; does other related duties.

REQUIREMENTS

EDUCATION: Successful completion of a training program in marine mechanics at a recognized vocational or technical school, resulting in certification to service and repair marine engines. Marine mechanics training programs completed in the United States Military are acceptable.

EXPERIENCE: Two (2) years of experience in the installation, maintenance, and repair of gasoline and diesel marine engines and related marine equipment.

NOTE: Applicants who do not possess the required education may substitute one (1) additional year of experience as indicated above.

LICENSE: Appointees will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.
