<u>DUTIES</u>: Under direction of a Crew Supervisor, applies paint, and other coating materials to various surfaces from ground level and/or scaffolds, platforms, and ladders at various heights, using brushes, rollers, and spray guns; follows accepted methods and uses proper materials and/or tools to prepare various surfaces for painting; cares for and cleans standard painting tools; May be required to travel throughout New Jersey to other locations. Residential location will be taken into consideration for a regional assignment, i.e., north, central, south region; does related work as required.

REQUIREMENTS

EXPERIENCE: Three (3) years of experience in work involving the painting and repainting of the interior and exterior of buildings and structures.

<u>NOTE:</u> Applicants not having the above experience may meet the requirements if they have the following: Successful completion of an apprentice painting program approved by the United States Department of Labor, Bureau of Apprenticeship and Training.

LICENSE: Appointees will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.

RESUME NOTE: Eligibility determinations will be based upon information presented in the resume only.
