

The indictment charges the defendants as follows, with the potential penalties

- Count One: Gang Criminality - (N.J.S.A. 2C: 33-29) First Degree - 15 to 30 years/\$200,000 fine. (All defendants)
- Count Two: Promoting Organized Street Crime - (N.J.S.A. 2C: 33-30) First Degree - 15 to 30 years/\$200,000 fine. (Scott, Bease, Cauthen, Porter and Alford)
- Count Three: Conspiracy - (N.J.S.A. 2C: 5-2) Second Degree - 5 to 10 years/\$150,000 fine. (All defendants EXCEPT Scott, Harker, Young and Teel)
- Count Four: Leader of a Narcotics Trafficking Network - (N.J.S.A. 2C: 35-3) First Degree - 25 years to Life/greater of \$750,000 fine or five times the street value. (Porter)
- Count Five: Conspiracy (Murder) (N.J.S.A. 2C: 5-2) - First Degree - 10 to 20 years/\$200,000 fine. (Scott and Bease)
- Count Six: Leader of a Narcotics Trafficking Network - (N.J.S.A. 2C: 35-3) First Degree - 25 years to Life/greater of \$750,000 fine or five times the street value. (Bease)
- Count Seven: Possession with Intent to Distribute CDS (N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5a(1) and N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5b(1)) - Second Degree - 5 to 10 years/\$150,000 fine. (All defendants EXCEPT Scott, Harker, Young and Teel)
- Count Eight: Possession with Intent to Distribute CDS (N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5a(1) and N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5b(11)) - Third Degree - 3 to 5 years/\$25,000 fine. (All defendants EXCEPT Scott, Harker, Young and Teel)
- Count Nine: Possession of CDS (N.J.S.A. 2C:35-10a(1)) - Third Degree - 3 to 5 years/\$35,000 fine. (All defendants EXCEPT Scott, Harker, Young and Teel)
- Count Ten: Possession of CDS (N.J.S.A. 2C:35-10a(3)) - Fourth Degree - 0 to 18 months /\$25,000 fine. (All defendants EXCEPT Scott, Harker, Young and Teel)
- Count Eleven: Leader of a Narcotics Trafficking Network - (N.J.S.A. 2C: 35-3) First Degree - 25 years to Life/greater of \$750,000 fine or five times the street value. (Cauthen)
- Count Twelve: Murder (N.J.S.A. 2C:11-3) - First Degree - 30 years to Life/\$200,000 fine. (Cauthen)
- Count Thirteen: Possession of a Weapon for an Unlawful Purpose (N.J.S.A. 2C:39-4) - Second Degree - 5 to 10 years/\$150,000 fine. (Cauthen)
- Count Fourteen: Unlawful Possession of a Weapon - (N.J.S.A. 2C:39-5) -Third Degree - 3 to 5 years/\$15,000 fine. (Cauthen)

- Count Fifteen: Certain Persons Not to Have Weapons - (N.J.S.A. 2C:39-7) - Second Degree - 5 to 10 years/\$150,000 fine. (Cauthen)
- Count Sixteen: Conspiracy - (N.J.S.A. 2C: 5-2) - Second Degree - 5 to 10 years/\$150,000 fine. (Bease, Cauthen, Wells, Allah-Shabazz and Frye)
- Count Seventeen: Tampering with Witnesses or Informants (N.J.S.A. 2C:28-5) - Second Degree - 5 to 10 years/\$150,000 fine. (Bease)
- Count Eighteen: Tampering with Physical Evidence - (N.J.S.A. 2C:28-6) - Fourth Degree - 0 to 18 months/\$10,000 fine. (Bease, Cauthen and Wells)
- Count Nineteen: Hindering Apprehension of Another - (N.J.S.A. 2C:29-3a) - Third Degree - 3 to 5 years/\$150,000 fine. (Bease, Wells, Allah-Shabazz and Frye)
- Count Twenty: Hindering Apprehension - (N.J.S.A. 2C:29-3b) - Third Degree – 3 to 5 years/\$150,000 fine. (Cauthen)
- Count Twenty-One: Unlawful Possession of a Weapon - (N.J.S.A. 2C:39-5) - Third Degree - 3 to 5 years/\$15,000 fine. (Alford)
- Count Twenty-Two: Certain Persons Not to Have Weapons - (N.J.S.A. 2C:39-7) - Second Degree - 5 to 10 years/\$150,000 fine. (Alford)
- Count Twenty-Three: Unlawful Disposition of a Weapon - (N.J.S.A. 2C:39-9d) - Fourth Degree - 0 to 18 months/\$10,000 fine. (Alford)
- Count Twenty-Four: Unlawful Possession of a Weapon - (N.J.S.A. 2C:39-5) - Third Degree - 3 to 5 years/\$15,000 fine. (Black)
- Count Twenty-Five: Certain Persons Not to Have Weapons - (N.J.S.A. 2C:39-7) - Second Degree - 5 to 10 years/\$150,000 fine. (Black)
- Count Twenty Six: Conspiracy (Murder) (N.J.S.A. 2C: 5-2) - First Degree - 10 to 20 years/\$200,000 fine. (Brinkley, Leary, Thomas and Williams)
- Count Twenty-Seven: Possession of a Weapon for an Unlawful Purpose - (N.J.S.A. 2C:39-4) - Second Degree - 5 to 10 years/\$150,000 fine. (Brinkley, Leary, Thomas and Williams)
- Count Twenty-Eight: Unlawful Possession of a Weapon - (N.J.S.A. 2C:39-5) - Second Degree - 5 to 10 years/\$150,000 fine. (Brinkley, Leary, Thomas and Williams)
- Count Twenty-Nine: Certain Persons Not to Have Weapons - (N.J.S.A. 2C:39-7) - Fourth Degree - 0 to 18 months/\$10,000 fine. (Leary)
- Count Thirty: Conspiracy - (N.J.S.A. 2C: 5-2) - Second Degree- 5 to 10 years/\$150,000 fine. (Scott, Young and Teel)
- Count Thirty-One: Bribery - (N.J.S.A. 2C: 27-2c) - Second Degree- 5 to 10 years/\$150,000 fine. (Scott and Young)

- Count Thirty-Two: Bribery- (N.J.S.A. 2C: 27-2c) - Second Degree- 5 to 10 years/\$150,000 fine. (Teel)
- Count Thirty-Three: Official Misconduct- (N.J.S.A. 2C: 30-2) - Second Degree - 5 to 10 years/\$150,000 fine. (Scott, Young and Teel)
- Count Thirty-Four: Unlawful Possession of Certain Electronic Devices in Correctional Facilities, (N.J.S.A. 2C:29-10b) - Third Degree/3 to 5 years/\$15,000 fine. (Scott)
- Count Thirty-Five: Unlawful Provision of Certain Electronic Devices in Correctional Facilities, (N.J.S.A. 2C:29-10c) - Third Degree - 3 to 5 years/\$15,000 fine. (Young)
- Count Thirty-Six: Unlawful Provision of Certain Electronic Devices in Correctional Facilities - (N.J.S.A. 2C:29-10d) - Third Degree - 5 to 10 years/\$150,000 fine. (Teel)
