NOTICE OF VIOLATION AND OFFER OF SETTLEMENT

Dear Mr. Patel:

The New Jersey Division of Consumer Affairs, Office of Consumer Protection ("Division"), is charged with enforcement of the New Jersey Consumer Fraud Act ("CFA"), **N.J.S.A. 56:8-1 et seq.**, specifically the Prohibition of Discrimination Against Cash-Paying Customers at, **N.J.S.A. 56:8-2.33**.

The CFA, specifically **N.J.S.A. 56:8-2.33(a)**, states:

A person selling or offering for sale goods or services at retail shall not require a buyer to pay using credit or prohibit cash as payment in order to purchase the goods or services. A person selling or offering for sale goods or services at retail shall accept legal tender when offered by the buyer as payment.

Further, the CFA, specifically **N.J.S.A. 56:8-2.33(b)**, states:

A person in violation of subsection (a) of [**N.J.S.A. 56:8-2.33**] shall be subject to a civil penalty of up to \$2,500 for a first offense and up to \$5,000 for a second offense, to be collected in a civil action by a summary proceeding under the "**Penalty Enforcement Law of 1999**," **P.L. 1999, c.274 (C.2A:58-10 et seq.)**. The Superior Court shall have jurisdiction of proceedings for the enforcement of the penalty provided by this section.

The Division has conducted an investigation of Hidden Grounds Coffee, LLC located at 100 Jersey Avenue, Unit 1, New Brunswick, New Jersey 08901 ("You," "Your," or "Yourself"), and has determined that You are in violation of the CFA (hereinafter

"Investigation"). As a result of the Division's Investigation, You have been found to have required a consumer to pay using a credit card or prohibited cash as payment in order to purchase goods or services, in violation of the CFA, specifically **N.J.S.A. 56:8-2.33**. The facts of the Investigation are set forth in the attached **Certification of Chief Investigator Edward George**.

IF YOU DO NOT CONTEST THE VIOLATION ALLEGED and wish to avail Yourself of this opportunity to settle the Investigation, You should **sign and return the Enclosed Answering Certification within fifteen (15) days** from the date of this **Notice of Violation ("Notice")** and agree to the following:

1. Cease and desist from further conduct that violates the CFA, including **N.J.S.A. 56:8-2.33 et seq.**,
2. Pay a civil penalty in the amount of \$1,000.00.

If the above-referenced payment is remitted, along with Your signed Answering Certification, You need not do anything further.

IF YOU DO NOT CONTEST THE VIOLATIONS ALLEGED, but wish to present information to Division representatives about any mitigating circumstances in Your case that may persuade the Division to reduce the civil penalty, you may request an informal **Mitigation Conference**. If You request a **Mitigation Conference**, You will waive Your right to an **Administrative Hearing**. The **Mitigation Conference** is scheduled for **Monday, July 25, 2022 at 10:00 A.M., at 124 Halsey Street, 7th Floor, Newark, New Jersey** with Chief Investigator Edward George, a representative of the Division. **You may be accompanied by an attorney. Due to COVID-19, this conference may take place as a conference call. Please confirm with Chief Investigator George at (973)-504-6339 or email GeorgeE@dca.njoag.gov.** Should You have any questions regarding this procedure, or seek an adjournment of this date, please contact **Chief Investigator George at (973) 504-6339 or by email GeorgeE@dca.njoag.gov.** Alternatively, **You may send written documentation to the Division** concerning any mitigating circumstances that You believe may persuade the Division to reduce the civil penalty. The Division will then review this material and respond to You. **In order to elect either of these options, You must return the enclosed Answering Certification within fifteen (15) days from the date of this Notice.**

IF YOU CONTEST THE VIOLATIONS ALLEGED, and do not wish to settle the matter consistent with the terms set forth above, **You may request a formal Administrative Hearing by returning the enclosed Answering Certification within fifteen (15) days from the date of this Notice.** In that event, this **Notice** will serve as notice of the violations against You. You should be aware that in making its final decision, the Division may, if violations of the above-referenced statutes have been proven, order civil penalties and remedies other than those in the settlement offer above. Specifically, You may be ordered to: pay civil penalties in an amount up to \$2,500 for the first violation, \$5,000 for the second violation, \$10,000 for the third violation and up to \$20,000 for the fourth violation and each subsequent violation, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 56:8-13 and N.J.S.A. 56:8-2.33, and pay investigative costs and attorneys' fees to the Division pursuant to N.J.S.A. 56:8-11 and 56:8-19.

Before a determination is made with regard to whether an **Administrative Hearing** will be conducted before the Director or referred to the Office of Administrative Law, a **Pre-Hearing Conference** will be held. If You request an **Administrative Hearing**, Your **Pre-Hearing Conference** will be scheduled on **July 25, 2022, at 10:00 A.M., at 124 Halsey Street, 7th. Floor, Newark, New Jersey** with Chief Investigator George, a representative of the Division. **You may be accompanied by an attorney. Due to COVID-19, this conference may take place as a conference call. Please confirm with Chief Investigator George.** Should You have any questions regarding this procedure, or seek an adjournment of this date, please contact **Chief Investigator George**, who may be reached at **(973) 504-6339 or email GeorgeE@dca.njoag.gov**. **Your attendance at this Pre-Hearing Conference is mandatory.** Any failure to appear without a satisfactory explanation may result in an order barring You from raising certain defenses at the **Administrative Hearing**, pursuant to **N.J.A.C. 1:1-14.4**. The purpose of this **Pre-Hearing Conference** is to discuss the issues in this matter and the defenses that You may wish to raise. You should be prepared to discuss the evidence You will propose to offer at the **Administrative Hearing**. It may be helpful if You bring to the **Pre-Hearing Conference** a copy of any documentation that supports Your position. If the Division determines that there are no material facts in dispute, You will have an opportunity to submit legal arguments and any documentation that may be relevant to the ultimate disposition of this matter. If there are material facts in dispute, an **Administrative Hearing** will be scheduled. During the **Administrative Hearing**, You, either personally or with the assistance of Your attorney, will have an opportunity to respond to the alleged violations, and submit evidence and present testimony as may be necessary for the Division to make a final determination.

IF YOU FAIL TO RESPOND within fifteen (15) days of the date of this Notice, the settlement offer will be withdrawn, and You will be deemed in default. The allegations against You will be deemed uncontested. Thereafter, this Notice and the underlying proofs may be reviewed by the Director of the Division, and a **Final Decision and Order on Default ("Final Order on Default")** will be issued, and You may be ordered to: pay civil penalties in an amount up to \$2,500 for the first violation, \$5,000 for the second violation, \$10,000 for the third violation and up to \$20,000 for the fourth violation and each subsequent violation pursuant to N.J.S.A. 56:8-13 and N.J.S.A. 56:8-2.33; and pay investigative costs and attorneys' fees to the Division pursuant to N.J.S.A. 56:8-11 and 56:8-19. You will receive no further notice from the Division prior to issuance of a Final Order on Default. Once a **Final Order on Default** has been entered, Your failure to pay any civil penalties, attorneys' fees and investigative costs within the time allowed will result in the filing of a **Certificate of Debt**. Any subsequent violation of a Final Order on Default with a cease and desist provision may subject You to a civil penalty of up to \$25,000 per violation pursuant to N.J.S.A. 56:8-18. Service of a **Final Order on Default** will be deemed effective if sent by first-class mail and certified mail, return receipt requested, to Your last known mailing address.

INVESTIGATIVE CERTIFICATION


I, Edward George, being of full age, do hereby certify as follows:

1. I am employed as an Investigator by the Office of the Attorney General, Division of Consumer Affairs, Office of Consumer Protection ("Division"), located at 124 Halsey Street, 7th Floor, Newark, New Jersey 07102.
2. On or about January 11, 2022, the Division received a complaint that Hidden Grounds, LLC, d/b/a Hidden Grounds Coffee located at 4C Easton Avenue New Brunswick, New Jersey 08901, prohibited cash as payment in order to purchase goods or services.
3. On May 13, 2022, the Division sent a Notice to Hidden grounds Coffee via certified mail, directing Hidden Grounds Coffee to cease and desist from prohibiting a buyer from using cash as payment pursuant to N.J.S.A. 56:8-2.33. The certified mail was delivered to Hidden Grounds Coffee on May 20, 2022. A copy of the Notice and proof of service are attached as **Exhibit A**.
4. On June 7, 2022 at approximately 1:00 p. m., I, arrived at Hidden Grounds Coffee located at 4 C Easton Avenue, New Brunswick, New Jersey 08901, to conduct an on-site inspection. A copy of the Inspection Sheet is attached as **Exhibit B**.
5. The purpose of the inspection was to determine whether Hidden Grounds Coffee was selling or offering for sale goods or services at retail and requiring a buyer to pay using credit or prohibit cash as payment in order to purchase the goods or services.
6. Upon arrival, acting in an undercover capacity, I spoke to an employee at Hidden Grounds Coffee, and inquired if I could pay for a cup of coffee with cash. The employee stated they only accepted credit, debit cards.
7. I explained to the employee I would have to go out to my vehicle to retrieve my credit card and left the premise.
8. At 1:05 p.m. I left Hidden Grounds Coffee.

9. On June 16, 2022, the Division ran a Detailed Corporation Information Inquiry report ("inquiry report"). The inquiry report indicates that Anand Patel is the registered agent of Hidden Grounds LLC. The inquiry report is attached hereto as **Exhibit C**.

10. All documents submitted with this Certification are true copies of documents in possession of the Division.

I certify that the foregoing statements made by me are true. I am aware that if any of the foregoing statements made by me are willfully false, I am subject to punishment.

Re: Hidden Grounds Coffee

To Whom It May Concern:

On March 18, 2019, New Jersey Governor Phil Murphy signed P.L. 2019, c.50 (N.J.S.A. 56:8-2.33), prohibiting any person, as defined by N.J.S.A. 56:8-1, selling or offering for sale goods or services at retail from: (1) requiring a buyer to pay using credit; or (2) refusing to accept cash as payment, in order to purchase the goods or services. A person selling or offering for sale goods or services at retail must accept legal tender when offered by the buyer as payment, unless exempted under the law.

The Division of Consumer Affairs, Office of Consumer Protection (the "Division") considers it to be a violation of N.J.S.A. 56:8-2.33 for a person to engage in any of the following retail sales practices:

- Prohibiting a buyer from using cash;
- Refusing cash payment due to a buyer's failure to use exact change; and
- Requiring a buyer to only use electronic payment methods (such as an app or an in-store kiosk) when making a purchase in-person at a physical retail location.

The Division may bring an enforcement action against a person for engaging in any of the retail purchase practices included in the non-exhaustive list above.

The Division has conducted an inspection of Hidden Grounds Coffee, during which our investigator determined that it is the practice of Hidden Grounds Coffee to not accept cash payment. These practices are unlawful under N.J.S.A. 56:8-2.33. Accordingly, you may be liable for an assessment by the Division of civil monetary penalties of up to \$2,500 for a first violation and \$5,000 for a second violation. Furthermore, a third violation of N.J.S.A. 56:8-2.33 constitutes an unlawful practice under the Consumer Fraud Act, N.J.S.A. 56:8-1 to -227 (the "CFA"), and is subject to civil penalties of up to \$10,000, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 56:8-13.

Although no final determination has been made, and the Division's investigation is ongoing, to the extent you are engaged in conduct in violation of the CFA, you are hereby directed to cease and desist such conduct. Please be guided accordingly.
