I would like to remind promoters that only licensed promoter/s, fighters, manager/s, and seconds that are listed on the NJSACB "Corner List" are allowed in the dressing rooms and ring area. (please reference letter date July 27, 2011)

Promoters, please assign credentials appropriately.

In addition, policy regarding "belt holders"; 1) they can walk to the ring; 2) will not be allowed inside the ring; and 3) they can only stand outside the ropes.

Your anticipated cooperation in this matter will make New Jersey events operate as smooth as possible.

I would like to address the traffic congestion in the dressing room areas and at ringside held at NJSACB combative events.

To help keep traffic to a minimum in dressing room areas and ringside, please give credentials only to participants, managers, and seconds who will be working in the contestant's corner and who are NJSACB licensed. This agency generates a "corner list" for each event which lists those individuals who are licensed. Only those individuals listed should gain entry to dressing rooms and ringside. A copy of the "corner list" is supplied to the promoter.

By implementing this practice, NJSACB will be in compliance with our policies, as well as helping to ensure the safety of all participants. In addition, this will free up space at ringside and the dressing rooms so the inspectors, physicians, media, and SACB staff, etc., can perform their duties in a more efficient and professional manner, instead of dealing with issues that may arise from overcrowded areas.
