At the commencement of the meeting, Chair Hatfield, pursuant to Section 5 of the Open Public Meetings Act, entered this announcement into the minutes of the meeting:

Adequate notice has been provided by the dissemination of a written "Annual Notice of Meeting." On December 17, 2015 a copy of such notice was:

- (a) prominently posted in a public place at the offices of the Public Employment Relations Commission;
- (b) sent to the business offices of the Trenton Times and the Courier Post, as well as to the State House press row addresses of 25 media outlets;
- (c) copies e-mailed to the Secretary of State for filing; and
- (d) posted on the agency's web site.

Furthermore on September 2, 2016, copies of an additional written "Notice of Special Meeting" were posted and sent in a similar manner.

A roll call was initiated to confirm the Commissioners that were present and participated via the telephone conference call.

The case for consideration was the draft decision in City of Orange Township and PBA Local 89, FMBA Local 10 and FMBA Local 210 Fire Officers Association, Docket Nos. IA-2010-101 and IA-2011-024. Commissioner Eskilson moved the draft decision and Commissioner Bonanni seconded the motion. Commissioner Wall was recused from voting on this matter because of his affiliation with the PBA. The motion to adopt the draft decision was approved by a vote of four in favor (Chair Hatfield, Commissioners Bonanni, Boudreau and Eskilson) and two opposed (Commissioners Jones and Voos).

Commissioner Eskilson made a motion to adjourn the meeting and Commissioner Boudreau seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously approved. The meeting was then adjourned.
