**PVSC Holds Annual Reorganization Meeting;
*Murphy, Quintana and Calabrese Re-Elected to Leadership Posts;
Memorial Bench Dedicated In Honor Of Former Commissioner Mildred Crump***

Newark, NJ – Commissioners Brendan Murphy and Luis Quintana were re-elected Chairman and Vice Chairman, respectively, at the Passaic Valley Sewerage Commission’s (“PVSC”) Annual Reorganization Meeting held yesterday. Additionally, Commissioner Elizabeth Calabrese was re-elected Board Treasurer and Thomas Fuscaldo was appointed Clerk to the Board of Commissioners.
