

# FUTURE LAND UTILIZATION

## A PRELIMINARY STUDY IN PRIMARY DISTRIBUTION



### LEGEND

- Present urban areas with an average population density of 300 or more per square mile.
- Areas of most probable urban expansion.
- Land generally suitable for continued farming.
- Land of low agricultural value; best devoted to forest production, recreation, protection of public water supply and incidental uses.

**NOTES No. 1**  
Both farming area and land shown as of low agricultural value include suitable sites for new community development, unpredictable as to occupancy for such use.

**NOTES No. 2**  
Indication is diagrammatic, showing only approximate boundaries and the larger areas in the several use categories.
