

New Jersey Cultural Trust FY19 Awards by County Round XIV Institutional Financial Stabilization Grants from the New Jersey State Council on the Arts

Wheaton Arts and Cultural Center	Cumberland	\$ 36,715	This grant will help support the replacement of ADA compliant curb cuts, wheelchair ramps, and enhancements for a restroom in the Museum of American Glass.
Montclair Art Museum	Essex	\$ 10,705	This grant will help support the purchase of a sound amplification system for the Museum's main community programming space, as well as a portable sound amplification system that can be used for
Roxey Ballet Company	Hunterdon	\$ 17,214	This NJSCA Cultural Trust grant will help support patrons' access to Roxey Ballet's black box theater with ADA-compliant performance seating. Owning this equipment will allow Roxey to stage even more performances and expand its award-winning Arts Education programs for students with special needs.
Grounds for Sculpture	Mercer	\$ 50,000	This grant will help support Grounds For Sculptures' resurfacing of the main park loop and paths, making it more accessible to visitors.
State Theatre Regional Arts Center	Middlesex	\$ 50,000	This grant will help support the installation of a patron and freight elevator at State Theatre New Jersey. Our upper level is currently inaccessible to patrons in wheelchairs or those with limited mobility. This new elevator will enable access to our loge and event space level.
Monmouth Museum	Monmouth	\$ 50,000	This grant will support the installation of an elevator connecting the lower level of the Museum to the second floor exhibition areas, workspaces, and staff offices, therefore improving access and services for people with disabilities.
Morris Museum	Morris	\$ 4,000	This grant will help support the creation of curb cuts at the Morris Museum's main entrance, making it more accessible to visitors, artists, and staff.
New Jersey Theatre Alliance	Morris	\$ 40,000	This grant will help support the purchase of looping equipment to assist individuals with hearing loss, especially those who wear hearing aids and those with cochlear implants. Equipment will be shared among the state's theatres and cultural community.
Appel Farm Arts & Music Center	Salem	\$ 50,000	This grant will help support the implementation of a comprehensive connectivity system at Appel Farm. The project will serve to create a physically inclusive campus that can be utilized year-round.
Frontline Arts	Somerset	\$ 3,161	This grant will help support greater public accessibility of our facility and improved communications by providing a single automatic door opener to our entrance and ADA-compliant signs communicating the entrance location and accessible studio levels.
