N.J.S.A. 19:61-9: AUDIT OF ELECTION
RESULTS 2025 GENERAL ELECTION
AUDIT DATE: Monday, November 17, 2025

On Monday, November 17, 2025, the Bergen County Board of Elections conducted an audit consistent with the provisions of N.J.S.A 19:61-9. The Board conducted a hand count of a random sampling of the Early Voting, Provisional, Mail-in and election day voting paper ballots from each Legislative District(35, 35, 37, 38, 39 and 40).

The total number of ballots cast with paper records was 347,825. The contests audited were:

1. Governor
2. State Senate
3. General Assembly
4. County-wide Office
5. Top Local Contest – Mayor/Council/Committee

Participating in the audit were 2 Board of Election Commissioners and 9 BOE office staff. As required, we did a combination of 2% of ballots and 2 audit units depending on the size of the Legislature District totaling 1731 ballots. The random batches are listed below.

All hand tallies matched the machine counts except:

- 1) ICC Mail-In - North Arlington - Liberty Vote calculated one less vote for Cengiz N. Sever.
- 2) ICC Mail-In - Bogota - Liberty Vote calculated one more vote for Mikie Sherrill, 1 vote for Joanne Kuniansky, and one more vote for Marco D. Navarro
- 3) ICC Mail-In - Teaneck - Liberty Vote calculated one more vote for Jack Ciattarelli
- 4) ICC Provisional - Franklin Lakes - Liberty Vote calculated one more vote for Jack Citterelli
- 5) ICC Mail-In - Paramus - Liberty Vote calculated one less vote for Mikie Sherrill, Lisa Swain, Christopher Tully, Thomas Sullivan, Mary Amoroso, Germaine Ortiz, Michelle Durrenberger and Peter Caminiti, Sr.

Errors(1-4)happened during the adjudication process(missed over-votes and marked ballots) and error(5) occurred from the mis-tally of one ballot. The rate of error in this audit was .288%.

The overall accuracy rate was 99.9%.
