**N.J.S.A. 19:61-9: AUDIT OF ELECTION RESULTS**

November 4, 2025 General Election

Audit Date: November 17, 2025

The Camden County Board of Elections (CC BOE) performed an audit consistent with provisions of N.J.S.A. 19:61-9. The audit was open to the public, and a board quorum was present.

The Camden County Board of Elections conducted a hand-to-eye count of the voter-verifiable paper records for the General Election for Governor, General Assembly, County Surrogate, and one municipal race, where available. The additional county races, municipal races, Board of Education, Fire Commissioner, and public questions were excluded from the audit.

Pursuant to the statute, "the audit shall be conducted in at least 2% of the election districts in which each audited election appears on the ballot." Camden County is comprised of one Congressional District. 28 units were chosen from Congressional District One.

Audit units included vote by mail ballots by municipality/ward that were received by November 10, 2025, with a timely postmark; provisional ballots by municipality/ward; votes cast during Early Voting on voting machines, and votes cast on Election Day voting machines. Tally sheets were prepared in advance of the audit for each municipality/ward.


There are 3 Legislative Districts in Camden County: 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup>. There were 307 audit units for the 4<sup>th</sup> Legislative Congressional District, and 6 batches were audited. There were 435 audit units for the 5<sup>th</sup> Legislative Congressional District, and 9 batches were audited. There were 660 audit units for the 6<sup>th</sup> Congressional District and 13 batches were audited. A total of 28 batches were audited.

The audit units contained no discrepancies. In each district, the hand to eye audit was 100% consistent with the machine tally. The ballot scanners use Intelligent Mark Recognition and Positive Target Recognition and Alignment Compensation technologies, to determine what ballot needed to be sent to adjudication computers for the final decision on voter intent.
