The Cape May County Board of Elections (CM BOE) performed an audit consistent with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 19:61-9.

The General Election held November 4, 2025, was conducted with Nine (9) days of early voting using the ESS Express Vote XL Ballot Marking Devices w/ paper ballots, Vote-By Mail Ballots, Provisional Ballots.

Pursuant to the statute 4 Units of the paper ballot batches for each Legislative District within Cape May County were to be audited. Cape May County is comprised of one (1) Legislative District.

The CM BOE conducted a hand-to-eye count of the paper records for the General Election held November 4, 2025, for the following offices: Governor, State of New Jersey General Assembly, County Clerk, Member of the Board of County Commissioners. Mayor

Audit units were comprised of early voting ballots, Election Day voting machines, vote-by-mail ballots, and provisional ballots.
