N.J.S.A. 19:61-9: AUDITS OF ELECTION RESULTS

November 4, 2025 General Election

Audit Date: November 18, 2025

The Gloucester County Board of Elections (GC BOE) performed a post-election audit consistent with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 19:61-9 and the guidelines promulgated by the New Jersey Secretary of State's Office.

The GC BOE conducted a hand-to-eye count of the voter-verifiable paper records for the November 4, 2025 General Election for the offices of Governor, General Assembly, County Commissioner, and either Mayor or Municipal Council/Committee. Fire District elections, Board of Education elections and pubic questions were excluded from the audit.

Audit units included: voter verified paper audit trails from each voting machine, vote by mail ballots by municipality; and provisional ballots by municipality.

There are three Legislative districts in Gloucester County: the 3rd, 4th, and 5th. Pursuant to the statute, based on the number of election districts in each Legislative District a random selection of 2% or at least (2) units/batches of all paper units/batches for each Legislative District were audited. The following audit units were randomly selected for audit on Monday, November 20, 2023.

In each batch, the hand to eye audit is listed in the table above reflecting audit to machine accuracy. Paper ballots which contained an overvote for a particular contest were recorded as an overvote and did not count as a vote.
