



## How to Complete and Return Your Vote-By-Mail Ballot

Here are some easy, step-by-step instructions on how to complete your vote-by-mail ballot, to make sure your vote counts.

### 1... Look inside the envelope you receive in the mail for these items:

- The ballot
- An inner envelope with an attached certificate
- A mailing envelope

### 2... Completely fill in the oval next to each of your selections in blue or black ink.

### 3... Fill in and sign the certificate, keeping it attached to the inner envelope.

### 4... Place the ballot into the certificate envelope.

### 5... Then, place the certificate envelope into the mailing envelope.

### 6... Return your ballot. How you return it is up to you. Select one of the following **three** ways:



**Mail:** It must be postmarked on or before 8:00 p.m. June 8 and be received by your county's Board of Elections on or before June 14.



**Secure Ballot Drop Box:** Place it in one of your county's secure ballot drop boxes by 8:00 p.m. on June 8. Drop box locations can be found at **Vote.NJ.Gov**.



**Board of Elections Office:** Deliver it in person to your county's Board of Elections Office by 8:00 p.m. on June 8. County Election Officials' contact information can be found at **Vote.NJ.Gov**.

**NOTE: Your vote-by-mail ballot CANNOT be returned to your polling place for this election.**
