

Typical Features of a 1960s-type Historical Marker
Placed during the New Jersey Tercentenary and Afterward

(all the markers in this series featured the same standard design; only the texts varied)

Top edge rises in center
to accommodate NJ
State seal

Flat, rectangular aluminum,
sheet metal plaque, painted
blue, with flat, upper-case
letters in buff, NJ's state
colors; bottom corners are
rounded

Corrugated steel post
