#	Question	Answer
1	Is this more of an RFI where you are asking the manufacturer and resellers to provide our capabilities?	No, NJDOT will be accepting a bid to provide the department Managed Print Services.
2	I don't see any current models or quantities on this bid. Is that something that you can provide?	Yes, NJDOT will provide a list of printer models. The print volume for 2023 was provided on the bid website (Current Bidding Opportunities, EMS, Procurement, Doing Business (nj.gov)) which should help in estimating the printer model necessary to continue or improve printing services.
3	Is there any chance that we can request an extension? The date of the mandatory walk through this is provided may conflict with some of our teams' availability.	The Bid Opening has been extended until April 2, 2024.
4	Lastly, the M2075 contract isn't a viable contract at this time. Does this HAVE to be on state contract? I know Lexmark recently received an agreement from NJ to be on the NASPO MPS agreement, but we're still going through the negotiations, and we're not officially on the contract yet. Please advise.	This is a Mini-Bid under an awarded NJ State Contract. Quotes received will be reviewed but ultimately awarded to a Vendor awarded under M2075 – Copiers and Managed Print Services – Statewide.
