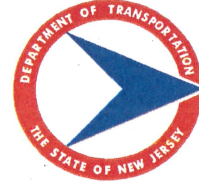

Baseline Document Change Announcement

ANNOUNCEMENT: BDC22S-20

SUBJECT: Certification of Compliance
- Revision to the 2019 Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction, Subpart 106.07.01.

Subpart 106.07.01 of the 2019 Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction has been revised in order to clarify that Certifications of Compliance are not required for materials that are temporary and not incorporated into the final construction. Certifications for Iron and Steel are excluded from this exemption.

The following revisions have been incorporated into the 2019 Standard Specifications via 2019 Standard Inputs, SI2019:

106.07.01 Certification of Compliance

THE FIRST PARAGRAPH IS CHANGED TO:

Submit manufacturer's Certifications of Compliance stating that the materials and assemblies fully comply with the requirements of the Contract when required by the Contract or requested by the Department, except for materials and assemblies that are temporary and not incorporated into the final construction and are not iron or steel such as sheeting and bridge assemblies. The State reserves the right to determine if a specific material or assembly meets this provision.

Implementation Code R (ROUTINE)

Changes must be implemented in all applicable Department projects scheduled for Final Design Submission at least one month after the date of the BDC announcement. This will allow designers to make necessary plan, specifications, and estimate/proposal changes without requiring the need for addenda or postponement of advertisement or receipt of bids.
